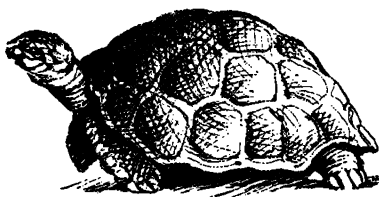

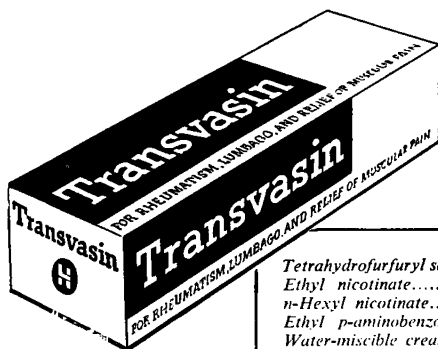

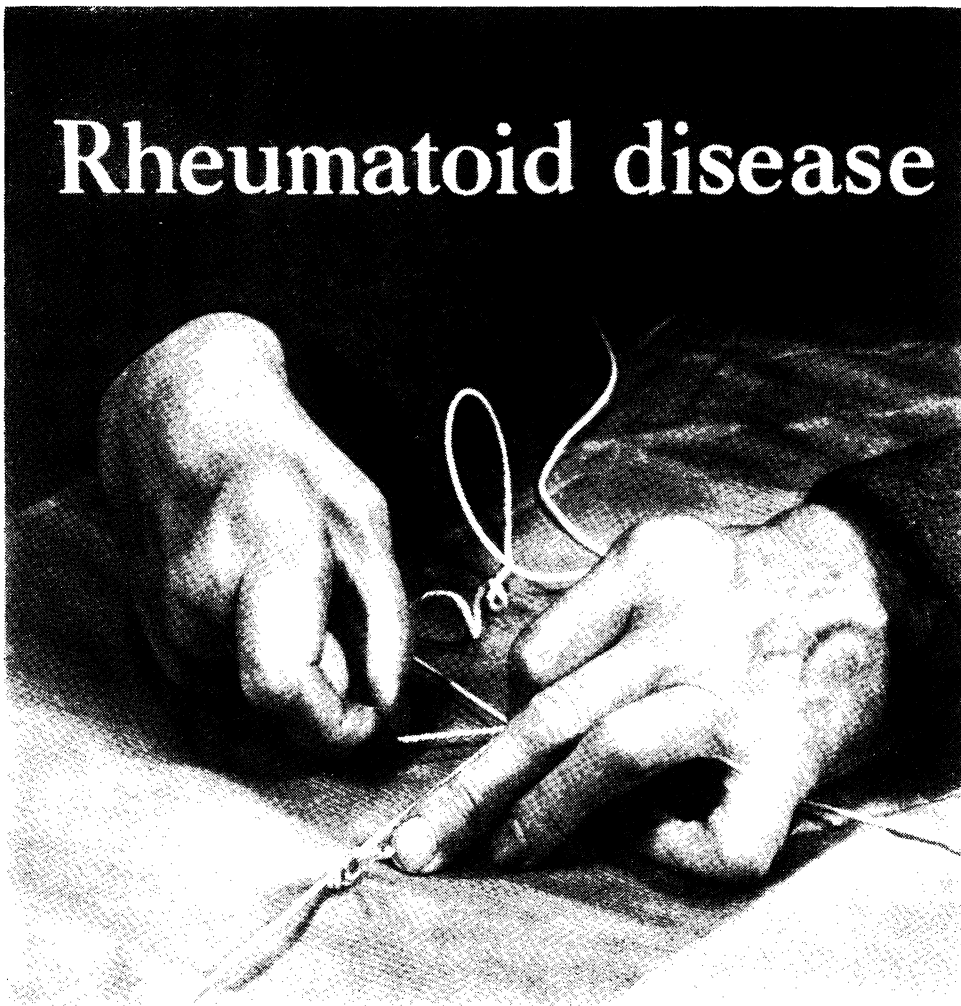

Safe Salicylate Therapy

Recent investigations have been made into the occurrence of gastro-intestinal haemorrhage following the use of ordinary aspirin in the treatment of rheumatic diseases.

"Out of the 95 patients who had reacted positively (to aspirin), 79 who needed further treatment with salicyl were given sodium salicylate instead of aspirin (10 patients were given ordinary tablets and 69 coated tablets). In all these cases the benzidine reaction became negative . . . As it was found that "entrosalyl" (coated sodium salicylate) never caused a positive benzidine reaction, those patients for whom salicyl therapy was desirable were given this medicine after they had stopped taking aspirin." 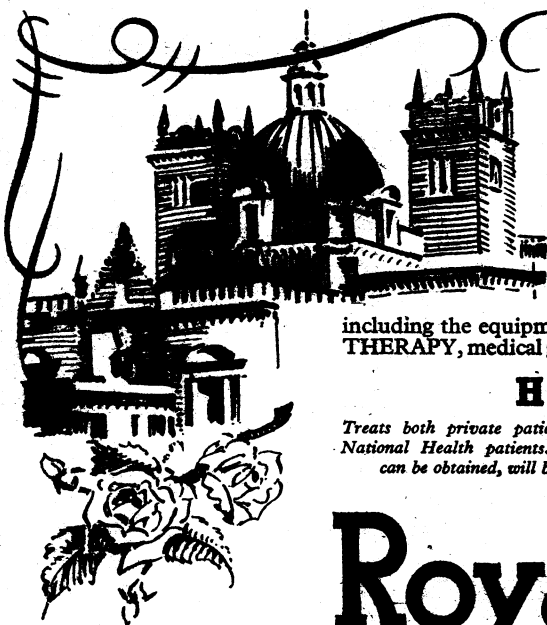
