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## Book review

**Multiple Choice Questions in Rheumatology.** By Ian D. Griffiths and P. Platt. Pp. 119. £3.95. Pitman: London, 1984.

This book forms part of a series in the medical specialties and subspecialties. The aims and method of use are clearly delineated in the foreword by the consulting editor, Dr John Anderson, and in the author's preface, which are both essential to the successful use of these MCQs. In particular their recommendation to follow up highlighted areas of ignorance together with a list of suitable texts for this purpose is eminently sensible. In addition useful short

comments are provided with the answers to initiate the educational aspect of these questions.

Undergraduates will find some of the questions beyond their expected knowledge. It is unfortunate that an acceptable score for different groups has not been included—such as undergraduates 40-60%, MRCP candidates 60-70%, senior registrar 90-100%, consultants classified information!

I found this book interesting, enjoyable, and instructive. Well worth recommending to those facing MCQ papers or who wish to identify blind spots worth eliminating.

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
